What if I don't live in the Olympic region?	Olympic Connect is the community care hub for the Olympic region serving Clallam, Jefferson, and Kitsap Counties. Olympic Connect will make a seamless connection and refer your client to the community care hub that serves the region where they live.
Is Olympic Connect open to anyone?	Yes, Olympic Connect serves anyone. Trusted helpers will work hand-in-hand with clients to navigate available services and resources.
